Dear Parishioners,

Holy Week and Easter: Parishioners may be interested to know that the attendances at all the Easter Liturgies were extremely good – better than they have been for a long time, so I have been told.

In addition to the excellent professional singers at the Passion Liturgy and the Easter Vigil, the Balmain Parish Choir sang at the Mass of the Last Supper and on Easter Day under the direction of our Director of Music Emeritus, David Hinder. Many parishioners were thrilled to hear, once again, "Come as you are" and "Morning is broken" as well as the solemn singing of the *Sing my tongue the glorious battle* in English and the *Tantum Ergo* in Latin. At Rozelle on Easter Sunday, Ann Tangney brought the organ to life assisted by a small group of singers. At both morning Masses, the congregations sang well. A small but willing band of servers assisted with their customary dedication. The readers were all very well prepared. A number of people commented on how powerful the Scripture readings at the Vigil were by reason of being so well read. The flowers at both churches were very beautiful on Easter Day. Thank you to everyone who contributed to a memorable celebration of the Sacred Triduum. Eastertide continues with joy for fifty days, culminating in the Feast of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost, so we are not finished yet.

The **5 pm Mass on Sunday** will be a family Mass during which there will be a Baptism. **Bible Study on Wednesdays** in the Presbytery at 7pm. The group is about to begin studying the *Acts of the Apostles* and taking direction from the early Church Fathers, particularly John Chrysostom and Augustine. Angela Finnigan 0414684447.

On Thursday, 11 April at 1.30 pm, pupils from Year 6 at the FJT School will be performing a Resurrection Play in the Balmain Church. Last year, the School put on a very impressive Passiontide Play.
